Fire Marshal Aleman was hired by Hallandale Beach Fire Rescue in December of 1995 as a Fire Safety Inspector and was appointed Fire Marshal in 2005. Fire Marshal Aleman has received his Bachelor Degree in Public Administration from Florida Atlantic University, an Associate Degree in Fire Science from Broward College, an Associate in Applied Science from the City University of New York, and is pursuing a Master's degree in Fire Protection Engineering.

The Fire Marshal is responsible for enforcing the Florida Fire Prevention Code, State Statutes, County Amendments, and City Ordinances. Fire Marshal Aleman participates as one of the fire investigation team members concerning fires that result in property loss, serious injury, or death in order to determine origin, cause, and circumstances. The Fire Marshal also participates in public education activities including demonstrations, presentations for the Community Emergency Response Team (CERT), and the Community Police Academy. Marshal Aleman also serves as one of the department's liaisons at the Broward County Emergency Operation Center during hurricane activations.
