Hallandale Scholarship Annual Report

The Hallandale Community Council Scholarship Fund has been in existence since 1961 to make a difference in the lives of students who dream of making a difference. Each year the Hallandale Community Council Scholarship Fund seeks scholarship applicants from high school seniors who reside in Hallandale Beach and dream of making a better life by pursuing a higher education. The goal of the Hallandale Community Scholarship Fund is to help develop today's youth into tomorrow's leaders.

Awards are made on a non-discriminatory basis to individuals who demonstrate excellence in scholastic, extracurricular and community service activities. Three different scholarships are open to residents of the City of Hallandale Beach who meet the required criteria for each scholarship.

Cum Laude Scholarship

- GPA 3.0 or higher weighted
- SAT 900 or higher
- ACT 18 or higher
- Must be accepted to a 4 year school

College Incentive Scholarship

- GPA 2.5 or higher weighted
- SAT 800 or higher
- ACT 17 or higher
- Must be accepted to a 2 or 4 year school

Tech Prep Scholarship

- Must attend a tech program at an accredited tech school or B.C.C. type institution

All must be residents of the City of Hallandale Beach, upon request must submit parent's current year tax return and submit a 50 to 100 word essay stating career goals and reason for selecting the college, university or tech school they have chosen.

The largest contributors to the fund are the Joslyn Moffitt-Perkins estate and other donations from local residences and businesses.
