

SUBJECT: Certification of Charter Amendments Referendum Results by City Commission

BACKGROUND

In accordance with the City Charter, Section 7.09, Results of election, the results of the Charter Amendment Referendum election of March 9, 2004 shall be considered adopted upon certification of the election results. The Official Results executed by Broward County officials is attached, with a description of the amendment questions and the results discussed below.

DISCUSSION

The official results of the number of votes cast for Hallandale Beach's March 9, 2004 Referendum regarding the seven proposed amendments to the City's Charter are as follows:

Amendment No. 1 Permitting the City Manager to Establish, Alter or Abolish any City Department of Agency:

"YES" VOTES 692

"NO" VOTES 1,305

Amendment No. 1 failed.

Amendment No. 2 Permitting the City Manager to extend franchises without an Ordinance:

"YES" VOTES 916

"NO" VOTES 1,068

Amendment No. 2 failed.

Amendment No. 3 Permitting Reorganization of the City Charter in a more Logical Order:

"YES" VOTES 1,761

"NO" VOTES 239

Amendment No. 3 passed.



Amendment No. 4 Permitting a Simplified Legal Description of the City's Corporate Limits:

"YES" VOTES 1,742
"NO" VOTES 189

Amendment No. 4 passed.

Amendment No. 5 Providing for a Commissioner's Forfeiture of Office for Failure to Attend Three (3) Consecutive Months of Regular Meetings:

"YES" VOTES 1,813
"NO" VOTES 195

Amendment No. 5 passed.

Amendment No. 6 Changing the Method of Election of the Mayor to an At Large Vote of the Electorate:

"YES" VOTES 1,557
"NO" VOTES 423

Amendment No. 6 passed.

Amendment No. 7 Providing for a Special Election when a Commission Seat becomes Vacant and no Regular Election is Scheduled within One Year:


"YES" VOTES 1,660
