

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING
BETWEEN THE CITY OF HALLANDALE BEACH AND THE CITY OF WEST PARK
CONCERNING CONSTRUCTION OF TEST WELLS AT MARY SAUNDERS PARK

The City of Hallandale Beach and the City of West Park share a common interest in ensuring the health, safety and welfare of their citizens. The City of Hallandale Beach is facing the prospect of saltwater intrusion in its water production wells. One possible solution to this challenge is the relocation of its production wells to a more westerly location. The City of West Park owns Mary Saunders Park on 4750 SW 21st Street within its City Limits and desires to work together with the City of Hallandale Beach in a manner that benefits both parties. It is deemed in the best interests of both the City of West Park and the City of Hallandale Beach to install two temporary sampling wells at Mary Saunders Park to obtain ground water quality samples and to determine the feasibility of installation of production wells at the southeast and southwest corners of the property. A map of the proposed locations is attached.

In consideration of these recitals, the parties agree to the following Memorandum of Understanding:

1. The City of West Park hereby agrees to provide access to Mary Saunders Park at the selected locations to the City of Hallandale Beach and its contractor beginning on August 17, 2009.
2. The City of Hallandale Beach hereby agrees to pay all costs for the test wells and to restore all property to its original condition or better. All work will take place between 7 AM and 7 PM Monday through Saturday.
3. The Contractor shall provide \$1 million of liability insurance, naming the City of West Park as additional insured.
4. The Contractor shall obtain all required permits, including but not limited to the City of West Park, Broward County EPD, the Broward County Health Department and the SFWMD. Further, the Contractor shall comply with all applicable state and federal environmental standards, laws, rules and regulations.

5. The City of Hallandale Beach shall report any unusual incidents, such as underground pipes breaks, to the City of West Park within three (3) hours.
6. The City of West Park must approve any water disposal plan.
7. Wells must be abandoned per all applicable federal, state and local governmental agency regulations. Wells, at a minimum, must be filled from bottom to top with neat cement grout by a licensed water well contractor.
8. Abandoned wells must not protrude above grade unless approved by the City of West Park.
9. Hallandale Beach shall provide West Park with a copy of all water quality reports within 48 hours of receiving reports.
