ATTENTION FLORIDA VOTERS!!!!!!

New Election Law Changes that may affect the way you vote.

OLD ELECTION LAW	NEW ELECTION LAW
15 Days of Early Voting 2 Sundays	8 Days of Early Voting Only 1 Sunday
Out of county address change during Early Voting and Election Day, vote a regular ballot	Out of county address change during Early Voting and Election Day, vote a provisional ballot
Pollworker could ask a voter to recite address on file	Pollworker can not ask a voter to recite their address on file
	Absentee Ballot instructions state that signature on file must match signature on voter certificate
Anyone could solicit and collect voter registration application without having to register with the State	Any person, entity, or organization that solicits and collects voter registration applications must register as a third party organization except: a person who registers their spouse, child, or parent; or an employee or agent working on behalf of the Division of Elections, Supervisor of Elections, DMV, or an official voter registration agency.

BE PREPARED!!!

- Verify your voting information with the Elections Office
 1. Update your signature on file
 2. Make sure your address on file is updated
(including building and apartment #'s)
 3. Make sure your absentee ballot request is current
- If voting in person, know your polling place or early voting location
- If voting by mail, don't forget to sign and date the voter certificate.
- Know your voter's rights & responsibilities
