

1.5 Time of Completion

The work to be completed under the terms and conditions of the contract shall be completed and delivered to the City within One-hundred and Eighty (180) calendar days from the receipt of a purchase order.

1.6 Minimum Qualifications

1.6.1 The manufacturer of all equipment provided under this contract shall be ISO 9001 certified.

1.6.2 All equipment shall be new and unused.

1.6.3 Vehicles must meet all Federal and State standards and regulations governing on-the-road vehicles of this vocation.

1.6.4 Successful Bidder shall have a successful track record of providing these types of vehicles to the industry. New or unproven technologies in key areas of the vehicle or body may be cause for rejection.

1.6.5 Vehicles shall conform in strength, quality of material and workmanship to that provided by the best manufacturing and engineering practices of the industry.

1.7 Bid Security

Bids must be accompanied by, a certified check or cashier's check drawn on a local bank in good standing, or a Bid Bond issued by a Surety authorized to issue such bonds in the State of Florida. The bid security shall be five percent (5%) of the total amount of the bid submitted for the purchase of seven (7) Garbage/Recycling Trucks (Base Price). This bid security shall be given as guarantee that the Bidder will not withdraw or modify his bid for a period of ninety (90) days after bid opening and if awarded the Contractor will execute said Contract. The Attorney-in-Fact (Resident Agent) who executes this bond in behalf of the Surety must attach a notarized copy of his power-of-attorney as evidence of his authority to bind the Surety on the date of execution of the bond. If the Bidder elects to furnish a Bid Bond, he shall use the Bid Bond form attached herein, or one conforming substantially thereto in form and content.

SECTION 2 - STANDARD TERMS AND GENERAL CONDITIONS**2.1 Addenda, Changes and Interpretations**

Any inquiry or request for interpretation received ten (10) or more days prior to the due date for the opening of the Bids will be given consideration. Changes or interpretations may only be made by a written document in the form of an addendum. Addenda will be issued via e-mail and sent to the e-mail address provided by each plan holder no later than seven (7) days prior to the bid opening date. Each prospective Bidder shall acknowledge receipt of such addenda in the space provided on the bid form. All addenda are a part of the contract documents and each Bidder will be bound by such addenda, whether or not received by Bidder. It is the responsibility of each prospective Bidder to verify that they have received all addenda issued before bids are opened. No verbal interpretations may be relied upon.

2.1.1 Failure to acknowledge receipt of addenda which affect price shall be considered a major irregularity; in which case, the bid will be deemed non-responsive.

2.1.2 Failure to acknowledge receipt of addenda which do not affect price shall be considered a minor irregularity; in which case, the bid will nevertheless be considered as though it had been received and acknowledged and the submission of a bid will constitute acknowledgment of the receipt of same.

2.2 Bidder Qualifications

Bidder shall be in the business of providing Automated Side Loading Garbage and Recycling Trucks and must possess sufficient financial support, equipment and organization to insure that it can satisfactorily perform the services if awarded a Contract. Bidders shall satisfy each of the following requirements cited below. Failure to do so will result in the Bid being deemed non-responsive.

2.2.1 Before awarding the Contract, the City reserves the right to require that a Bidder submit such evidence of his/her qualifications as the City may deem necessary. Further, the City may consider any evidence of the financial, technical, and other qualifications and abilities of a Bidder, including previous experiences of same with the City and performance evaluation for services, in making the award in the best interest of the City.

2.2.2 Bidder shall have no record of judgments, pending lawsuits against the City or criminal activities involving moral turpitude and not have any conflicts of interest that have not been waived by the City Commission.

2.2.3 Neither Bidder nor any principal, officer, or stockholder of Bidder(s) shall be in arrears or in default of any debt or contract involving the City, (as a party to a contract, or otherwise); nor have failed to perform faithfully on any previous contract with the City.

2.3 Qualifications Statement

Each Bidder shall complete the Qualifications Statement, and submit the same with his bid. Failure to submit the Qualifications Statement and the documents required there under with the bid may constitute grounds for rejection of the bid.

2.4 Bidder's Experience Record

The City shall have the right to investigate the financial condition and experience record of each prospective Contractor and determine to its satisfaction the competency of each to undertake the project requested by this bid.

2.5 Bidder's Cost

The City shall not be liable for any costs incurred by Bidders in responding to this ITB.

2.6 Bid Acceptance

Any bid may be withdrawn up until the bid opening date and time (due date). Any bid not so withdrawn shall upon opening constitute as an irrevocable offer to the City to provide the products and/or services set forth in the ITB. Bidder warrants by virtue of submitting a Bid that the Bid and the prices quoted will be firm for acceptance by the City for a period of ninety (90) days from the date of ITB opening unless otherwise stated in the ITB.

2.7 Nonexclusive Contract/Additional Services

Bidder agrees and understands that the Contract shall not be construed as an exclusive arrangement and further agrees that the City may, at any time, secure similar or identical products or services at its sole option.

2.8 Mistakes

Bidders are cautioned to examine all terms, conditions, specifications, drawings, exhibits, addenda, delivery instructions, and special conditions pertaining to the ITB. Failure of the Bidder to examine all pertinent documents shall not entitle him to any relief from the conditions imposed in the contract and may lead to rejection of a bid.

2.9 Contract Administration

Overall performance under the resultant contract shall be supervised by the Director of Environmental Services, or designee. If at any time during the contract period, performance is deemed to be unsatisfactory the City shall issue a formal Notice of Default to the Contractor. Upon notification by the City, Contractor shall take such necessary steps to cure the default as per contract requirements. If at any time, in the opinion of the City, there has been a breach of contract, the Contractor shall be notified and a hearing shall be set for a date within fifteen (15) days of such notice. At that time, the Risk Management Division, or their designees, shall hear the Contractor and City representatives. The City shall make a determination as to whether or not there have been a breach of contract, and shall direct what further action shall be taken.

2.10 Rejection of Bids

The City reserves the right to accept or reject any or all bids, part of bids, and to waive minor irregularities or variations to specifications contained in bids, and minor irregularities in the bid process.

2.11 Protest Procedures

In accordance with Section 38-139 of the City of Deerfield Beach Code of Ordinances, if a Bidder intends to protest a solicitation or proposed award the following shall apply:

2.11.1 Any Bidder who is aggrieved in connection with the pending award of a contract or any element of the process leading to the award of or contract may protest to the Purchasing Manager. A protest must be filed within five business days after notification of the recommendation of the selection/evaluation committee or any right to protest is forfeited. The protest must be in writing, must identify the name and address of the protester, and must include a factual summary of, and the basis for, the protest. Filing shall be considered complete when the protest is received by the Purchasing Manager.

2.11.2 Upon receipt of a protest of the pending award of a contract, the Purchasing Manager shall review the charge to determine whether the protest was timely filed. If upon review

the Purchasing Manager determines that the protest was not timely filed, the Purchasing Manager shall dismiss the protest. If it is determined that the protest was timely filed, the Purchasing Manager shall notify all Bidders of the protest and inform them of the scheduled hearing before the City Commission and of their right to intervene. Any Bidder may formally intervene in the proceeding by filing a request to intervene with the Purchasing Manager.

2.11.3 The Purchasing Manager shall require a deposit from a protester to compensate the City for the expenses of administering the protest. If the protest is decided in the protester's favor, the entire deposit shall be returned to the protester. If the protest is not decided in the protester's favor, the deposit shall be forfeited to the City. The deposit shall be in the form of cash, a cashier's check, or a payment bond and shall be in the amount of 1% of the amount of the pending award, with a minimum deposit of \$250 and a maximum deposit of \$1,000.

2.11.4 The protester and intervener(s) may file written documentation relating to the protest with the Purchasing Manager. It shall be the obligation of such protester or intervener(s) to deliver said documentation at least one week prior to City Commission action on the protest.

2.11.5 The City Commission may hear from the protester and intervener(s) in its discretion or may dispose of the protest without permitting presentations on the protest. If, on its face, the protest does not state sufficient cause to warrant remedial action, the City Commission may deny the protest without further participation by the protester or intervener(s). The Commission, in its sole discretion, may deny the protest, grant the protest and fashion relief or remedial action as it deems appropriate, or reject all bids and begin the ITB process again.

2.12 Legal Requirements

Applicable provisions of all federal, state, and county laws, and local ordinances, rules and regulations, shall govern development, submittal and evaluation of all bids received in response hereto and shall govern any and all claims and disputes which may arise between person(s) attaching a bid response hereto and the City by and through its officers, employees and authorized representatives, or any other person, natural or otherwise. Lack of knowledge by any Bidder shall not constitute a cognizable defense against the legal effect thereof.

2.13 Background Checks

2.13.1 In accordance with Section 38-117 of the City of Deerfield Beach Code of Ordinances, prior to beginning any services under this Invitation to Bid, the Contractor shall provide the City with a list of all employees who will have access to City property. The City shall obtain a criminal background check through the National Crime Information Center (NCIC) at the expense of the Contractor for each of the Contractor's employees prior to any employee of the company who is doing the work required by this bid having access to City property. The Contractor must ensure a similar check has been done of its Subcontractors' employees who will have access to the City's property.

2.13.2 If such a check reveals a conviction or a plea of nolo contendere, regardless of when the plea or conviction occurred, which includes a felony or misdemeanor involving terrorist behavior, violence, use of a dangerous weapon, crimes of moral turpitude or breach of

trust/fiduciary responsibility or which raises concerns about building, system, or personal security or is otherwise a job-related crime, the awarded Bidder shall not assign the individual to any City property. If such a check reveals any of the foregoing after access has already been granted, any access privileges already granted shall be immediately revoked and shall not be reinstated without the City's express written authorization. In the event that the Bidder intends to hire new personnel to perform the required services, the background checks should be initiated at the time of the hire.

2.13.3 The City reserves the right to approve or disapprove whether Contractor's employees perform the services for the City. Disapproval would apply solely to this bid and shall have no bearing on the Bidder's employment of an individual outside of this bid.

2.13.4 The awarded Bidder shall certify compliance with this provision prior to commencing work by submitting the Background Check Affidavit (attached) to the Purchasing Division and the City Clerk. The Notice to Proceed shall not be issued by the Purchasing Division until the Affidavit is submitted.

2.14 Public Records / Confidential Information

Florida law provides that municipal records shall at all times be open for personal inspection by any person, unless otherwise exempt. Information and materials received by the City in connection with a Bidder's response shall be deemed to be public records subject to public inspection. However, certain exemptions to the public records law are statutorily provided for in Section 119.07, F.S. Section 119.07, F.S. provides an exemption from public records law for sealed bids, bids, or replies received by an agency pursuant to a competitive solicitation until such time as the agency provides notice of an intended decision or until 30 days after opening the bids, bids, or final replies, whichever is earlier.

If the Bidder believes any of the information contained in his or her response is exempt from the Public Records Law, then the Bidder must in his or her response specifically identify the material which is deemed to be exempt and cite the legal authority for the exemption, otherwise, the City will treat all materials received as public records.

2.15 Special Conditions

Any and all Special Conditions contained in this ITB that may be in variance or conflict with the General Conditions shall have precedence over the General Conditions. If no changes or deletions to General Conditions are made in the Special Conditions, then the General Conditions shall prevail in their entirety.

2.16 Conflict of Interest

2.16.1 The Bidder covenants that they presently have no interest and shall not acquire any interest, directly or indirectly, which would conflict in any manner or degree with the performance of the services hereunder. The Bidder further covenants that no person having any such known interest shall be employed or conveyed an interest, directly or indirectly, in the contract.

2.16.2 No contract will be awarded to a Bidder who has City elected officials, officers or employees affiliated with it, unless the Bidder has fully complied with current Florida State Statutes and City Ordinances relating to this issue. Bidders must disclose any such affiliation. Failure to disclose any such affiliation will result in disqualification of the Bidder

and removal of the Bidder from the City's Bidder's List and prohibition from engaging in any business with the City.

2.17 Indemnification

The Contractor shall at all times indemnify, hold harmless and, at City Attorney's option, defend or pay for an attorney selected by City Attorney to defend the City of Deerfield Beach, its officers, agents, servants, and employees from and against any and all causes of action, demands, claims, losses, liabilities and expenditures of any kind, including attorney fees, court costs, and expenses, caused or alleged to be caused by intentional or negligent act of, or omission of the Contractor, its employees, agents, servants, or officers, or accruing, resulting from, or related to the subject matter of this Contract including, without limitation, any and all claims, losses, liabilities, expenditures, demands or causes of action of any nature whatsoever resulting from injuries or damages sustained by any person or property. In the event any lawsuit or other proceeding is brought against the City by reason of any such claim, cause of action or demand, the Contractor shall, upon written notice from the City, resist and defend such lawsuit or proceeding by counsel satisfactory to the City or, at City's option, pay for an attorney selected by the City Attorney to defend City. The provisions and obligations of this section shall survive the expiration or earlier termination of this Contract. To the extent considered necessary by the Contract Administrator and the City Attorney, any sums due Contractor under this Contract may be retained by City until all of City's claims for indemnification pursuant to this Contract have been settled or otherwise resolved; and any amount withheld shall not be subject to payment of interest by City.

2.18 Waiver

It is agreed that no waiver or modification of this contract or of any covenant, condition or limitation contained in it shall be valid unless it is in writing and duly executed by the party to be charged with it, and that no evidence of any waiver or modification shall be offered or received in evidence in any proceeding, arbitration, or litigation between the parties arising out of or affecting this contract, or the right or obligations of any party under it, unless such waiver or modification is in writing, duly executed as above. The parties agree that provisions of this paragraph may not be waived except by a duly executed writing.

2.19 Survivorship Rights

This contract shall be binding on both parties to the benefit of the respective parties and their executors, administrators, heirs, personal representative, successors and assignees.

2.20 Entire Agreement

This Invitation to Bid, all attachments and exhibits, addenda, and the resulting Contract attached states the entire contract between the parties hereto with respect to the subject matter hereof, an all prior and contemporaneous understandings, representations and agreements are merged herein or superseded hereby. No alterations, modifications, release or waiver of this contract or any provisions hereof shall be effective unless in writing executed by the parties.

2.21 Severability

If any term or provision of this contract is found to be illegal and unenforceable, such term(s) shall be deemed stricken and the remainder of the contract shall remain in full force and effect.

2.22 Default and Termination**2.22.1 Termination for Cause**

In the event the Contractor shall default in any of the terms, obligations, restrictions or conditions in the contract documents, the City shall give the Contractor written notice by registered, certified mail of the default and that such default shall be corrected or actions taken to correct such default shall be commenced within three (3) calendar days thereof. In the event the Contractor has failed to correct the condition(s) of the default or the default is not remedied to the satisfaction and approval of the City, the City shall have all legal remedies available to it, including, but not limited to termination of the Contract in which case the Contractor shall be liable for any and all damages permitted by law arising from the default and breach of the contract.

2.22.2 Termination for Convenience

Upon thirty (30) calendar days written notice to the Contractor, the City may without cause and without prejudice to any other right or remedy, terminate the contract for the City's convenience whenever the City determines that such termination is in the best interest of the City. Where the contract is terminated for the convenience of the City the notice of termination to the Contractor must state that the contract is being terminated for the convenience of the City under the termination clause and the extent of termination. The Contractor shall discontinue all work on the appointed last day of service.

2.22.3 Cancellation for Unappropriated Funds

The obligation of the City for payment to a Contractor is limited to the availability of funds appropriated in a current fiscal period, and continuation of the contract into a subsequent fiscal period is subject to appropriation of funds, unless otherwise authorized by law.

2.23 Independent Contractor

The Bidder represents itself to be an independent firm offering such products or services to the general public and shall not represent itself or its employees to be employees of the City of Deerfield Beach. Therefore, the Bidder shall assume all legal and financial responsibility for taxes, FICA, employee fringe benefits, workers compensation, employee insurance, minimum wage requirements, overtime, and other expenses, and agrees to indemnify, save, and hold the City of Deerfield Beach, its officers, agents, and employees, harmless from and against, any and all loss; cost (including attorney fees); and damage of any kind related to such matters.

2.24 Ethics Code

Bidders are required to acquaint themselves with the provisions in the City of Deerfield Beach's Ethics Code (Ordinance No. 2009/06). The City Commission will strictly apply the Ethics Code. Section (5) "Disclosure and Behavior Requirements of Applicants and Person/Entity seeking a City contract or currently doing business with the City" is of immediate interest. Bidder shall complete the Disclosure Form (attached). Failure to do so may result in the in the Bidder's bid being deemed non-responsive.

2.25 No Contingent Fee

Bidder warrants that it has not employed or retained any company or person, other than a bona fide employee working solely for the Bidder to solicit or secure the Contract and that it has not paid or agreed to pay any person, company, corporation, individual or firm, other than a bona fide employee working solely for the Bidder, any fee, commission, percentage, gift, or other consideration contingent upon or resulting from the award or making the Contract. For the breach

or violation of this provision, the City shall have the right to terminate the Contract without liability at its discretion.

2.26 Variances

2.26.1 For purposes of bid evaluation, Bidders must indicate any variances, no matter how slight, from the ITB General Conditions, Special Conditions, Technical Specifications or Addenda. No variations or exceptions by a Bidder will be considered or deemed a part of the bid submitted unless such variances or exceptions are listed in the ITB and referenced in the space provided on the bid pages. If variances are not stated, or referenced as required, it will be assumed that the product or service fully complies with the City's terms, conditions, and specifications.

2.26.2 By receiving a bid, the City does not necessarily accept any variances contained in the ITB. All variances submitted are subject to review and approval by the City. If any bid contains material variances that in the City's sole opinion, makes that bid conditional in nature, the City reserves the right to reject the bid or part of the bid that is declared, by the City, as conditional.

2.27 Multiple Bids

More than one (1) bid from an individual, firm, partnership, corporation, or association under the same or different names will not be considered. Such a circumstance will lead to rejection of all responses in which the Bidder is involved except for sub-Bidders. If there is reason to believe that collusion exists between Bidders, those parties' bids will be rejected and deemed for City purposes to be a conviction of a public entity crime.

This provision is not meant to prohibit submission of "alternate" bids which are being offered as options for consideration within the same bid.

2.28 Public Entity Crimes Information Statement

A person or affiliate who has been placed on the convicted vendor list following a conviction for public entity crime may not submit a bid on a contract to provide any goods or services to a public entity, may not submit a bid on a contract with a public entity for the construction or repair of a public building or public work, may not submit bids on leases of real property to public entity, may not be awarded or perform work as a Bidder, supplier, subcontractor, or consultant under a contract with any public entity, and may not transact business with any public entity in excess of the threshold amount provided in Section 287.017, for category two for a period of thirty-six (36) months from the date of being placed on the convicted vendor list.

2.29 Anti-Collusion

The Bidder certifies that it has not divulged, discussed or compared its bid with other Bidders, except subcontractors if they form part of the response and has not colluded with any other Bidders or parties to a bid whatsoever. No premiums, rebates or gratuities are permitted either with, prior to, or after any delivery of material or service. Any violation of this provision will result in the immediate cancellation of the contract and removal from the Bidder's list.

Each Bidder shall complete the Non-Collusive Affidavit Form (attached) and shall submit the form with the Bid. The City considers the failure of the Bidder to submit this document to be a major irregularity and shall be cause for rejection of the Bid.

2.30 Sub-Contractors

If the Bidder proposes to use subcontractors in the course of providing these products and/or services to the City, this information shall be a part of the Bidder's response. Such information shall be subject to review, acceptance and approval of the City, prior to any Contract award. The City reserves the right to approve or disapprove of any proposed subcontractor in its best interest.

2.31 Cone of Silence

In accordance with Section 38-140 of the City of Deerfield Beach Code of Ordinances, during the course of a competitive solicitation; a Cone of Silence shall apply as follows:

2.31.1 A Cone of Silence shall be in effect during a Competitive Solicitation beginning upon the advertisement for invitations to bid, requests for bids, requests for qualifications, or other competitive solicitation. The Cone of Silence shall terminate at the time the City Commission makes final award of a bid or gives final approval of a contract or contract amendment, rejects all bids or responses to the Competitive Solicitation, or takes other action which ends the Competitive Solicitation. The Cone of Silence shall continue through the negotiation phase for requests for bids and requests for qualifications and shall not end until the Commission gives final approval of the contract.

2.31.2 Any person or entity that seeks a contract, contract amendment, award, recommendation, or approval related to a Competitive Solicitation or that is subject to being evaluated or having its response evaluated in connection with a Competitive Solicitation, including a person or entity's representative shall not have any communication with any City Commissioner, the City Manager and their respective support staff or any person or group of persons appointed or designated by the City Commission or the City Manager to evaluate, select, or make a recommendation to the City Commission or the City Manager regarding a Competitive Solicitation.

2.31.3 The Cone of Silence shall not apply to written or oral communications with legal counsel for the City or the Purchasing Manager for the City.

2.31.4 Any action in violation of this section shall be cause for disqualification of the bid or the bid. The determination of a violation shall be made by the City Commission.

2.32 Small Disadvantaged Business Entity (SDBE)

In accordance with Section 38-146 of the City of Deerfield Beach Code of Ordinances, during the course of a competitive solicitation, a Small Disadvantaged Business Entity preference shall apply as follows:

2.32.1 The city commission does hereby establish a goal of 15 percent participation by SDBEs for all competitively bid contracts in excess of \$50,000.00. Such participation shall be a goal of the City of Deerfield Beach City Commission and shall be subject to the terms and the conditions set forth herein. The SDBE Participation Affidavit, to be filed with all competitive bids, is attached below.

2.32.2 Unless specifically exempted by resolution of the city commission, or otherwise set forth herein, each contract which is competitively bid or the subject of a request for proposal shall include a requirement that the contractor commit to the expenditure of at least 15 percent of the contract award with one or more SDBEs where the city estimates that the eventual cost will exceed \$50,000.00. This requirement may be completely or partially waived by the city commission or city manager if it is determined that a different

percentage commitment should apply based upon the availability and capacity of SDBEs in the applicable industry, service or commodity or where the city commission or city manager determines that the goods or services sought will not require the use of subcontractors. A business enterprise owned by a woman who is a member of a minority group may be counted on a particular contract as an MBE or WBE but not both. This commitment may be met by contractor status as MBE or WBE, or by a joint venture with one or more MBEs or WBEs as prime contractor to the extent of the MBE or WBE participation in such joint venture, or by subcontracting a portion of the work to one or more MBEs or WBEs by the purchase of materials or services for the work from one or more MBEs or WBEs, or by the indirect participation of MBEs or WBEs in other aspects of the contractor's business but no dollar amount of such indirect MBE or WBE participation shall be credited more than once against a contractor's MBE or WBE commitment with respect to all contracts of such contractor, or by any combination of the foregoing. Unless exempted or waived as set forth above, a contractor's bid is non-responsive if it does not identify the SDBE utilization and contain a commitment to at least the SDBE percentage commitment stated in the contract specifications unless SDBE unavailability documentation, a copy of which is attached hereto, is accurately completed and submitted with the bid. The city manager may change the form of the affidavits required.

2.32.3 In all contracts governed by this subdivision SDBE participation (or as required in bid specifications or requests for proposal) or an effort to secure said participation shall be deemed a part of the award evaluation process. The city commission may, by motion, require the provisions of this subdivision to apply to requests for proposals or other contract awards.

2.33 Licenses and Certifications

The Bidder shall be appropriately licensed to perform the work. Bidder shall possess at the time of bid opening all required licenses and certifications. The Bidder shall be responsible for all costs associated with obtaining and maintaining all required licenses, certifications, and permits.

2.34 Insurance

2.34.1 The Bidder's response shall include a copy of any certificate of insurance which provides evidence of insurability meeting the minimum insurance requirements stated in the Special Terms and Conditions. The Bidder shall assume full responsibility and expense to obtain all necessary insurance.

2.34.2 The successful Bidder shall not commence operations pursuant to the terms of this ITB and the attached Contract, until certification or proof of the insurance requirements set forth within the attached Contract have been received and approved by the Insurance Services Manager. Any questions as to the intent of meaning of any part of the insurance requirements set out in the attached contract should be directed to the Insurance Services Manager at (954) 426-6897.

2.35 Omission of Details

The apparent silence of the specifications and any amendment regarding any details or the omission from the specifications of a detailed description concerning any services or material requested, shall be regarded as unintentional and should not serve to alleviate the contractor of their performance responsibilities.

2.36 Advertising

In submitting a bid, the Bidder agrees not to use the results there from as a part of any commercial advertising without the prior written consent of the City.

2.37 Other Governmental Agencies

If the Bidder is awarded a Contract as a result of this ITB, Bidder will, if Bidder has sufficient capacity or quantities available, provide to other government agencies, so requesting, the products or services awarded in accordance with the terms and conditions of the ITB and resulting Contract. Prices shall be F.O.B. Destination to the requesting Agency.

2.38 Venue

The parties waive the privilege of venue and agree that all litigation between them in the state courts shall take place in Broward County, Florida and that all litigation between them in the federal courts shall take place in the Southern District in and for the State of Florida.

2.39 Assignment

Contractor shall not transfer or assign or subcontract the performance required by this ITB without the prior written consent of the City. Any award issued pursuant to this ITB, and the monies, which may become due hereunder, are not assignable except with the prior written approval of the City Manager or selected designee.

SECTION 3 - SPECIAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS**3.1 ITB Schedule**

The City will use the following tentative schedule in the competitive solicitation process. The City reserves the right to change and/or delay scheduled events.

3.2 Submission and Receipt of Bids

3.2.1 One (1) clearly marked original and two (2) copies of the bid shall be submitted on or before the due date and time, Wednesday, November 2, 2011 at 2:30 p.m. EST, in one single sealed envelope or package. Faxed bids will not be accepted under any circumstances. The City shall not be responsible for the premature opening of a Bid not properly marked and identified as required herein. The envelope shall be clearly marked on the exterior with the following information:

3.2.2 Any erasures or corrections on the bid must be made in ink and initialed by the Bidder in ink. All information submitted by the Bidder shall be printed, typewritten or filled in with pen or ink. Bidders shall use the bid forms provided by the City. Failure to use the forms may cause the bid to be rejected and deemed non-responsive.

3.2.3 Bids must contain a manual signature of the authorized representative of the Bidder. The address, e-mail and telephone number for communications regarding the Bid must be shown.

3.2.3.1 Bids by corporations must be executed in the corporate name by the President or other corporate officer accompanied by evidence of authority to sign. The corporate address and state of incorporation must be shown below the signature.

3.2.3.2 Bids by partnerships must be executed in the partnership name and signed by a partner, whose title must appear under the signature and the official address of the partnership must be shown below the signature.

3.2.4 All bids received from Bidders in response to the Invitation to Bid will become the property of the City of Deerfield Beach and will not be returned to the Bidders. In the event of

Contract award, all documentation produced as part of the Contract shall become the exclusive property of the City.

- 3.2.5 Bids will be publicly opened in the Purchasing Division, 2nd Floor, 401 SW 4th Street, Deerfield Beach, FL 33441. Bidders and the public are invited to attend. Bids will be tabulated and made available for review by Bidders and the public in accordance with applicable regulations.

3.3 Contract Award

- 3.3.1 The City shall determine which Bidders are responsible and responsive, quoting the lowest price for the items indicated on the Bid Schedule. It is the intent of the City to award the Contract to the lowest responsive and responsible bidder. However, the City reserves the right to award the Contract by group or item.
- 3.3.2. The City reserves the right to accept or reject any or all bids. The City also reserves the right to waive minor irregularities or variations to the specifications and in the competitive solicitation process.
- 3.3.3 A recommendation of award to the lowest responsive and responsible Bidder will be made to the City Commission. The City Commission has the ultimate authority to approve and/or reject any and all bids. Upon approval by the City Commission, the City Manager is authorized to execute a Contract on behalf of the City.
- 3.3.4 The City shall issue a Purchase Order and Notice to Proceed to the Contractor. The Contractor's receipt of a Purchase Order and Notice to proceed shall begin the required time of competition for this project.

3.4 Purchase and Leasing Options

3.4.1 Purchase

The number of actual units purchased may vary but will not exceed seven (7) trucks in total. Therefore, the City is requesting Bidder's provide a price for the purchase of one (1) truck and volume discount price percentage for quantities up to seven (7).

3.4.2 Buyback

If available, Bidder shall provide a guaranteed buyback option for the above new truck purchases. The buyback option shall be presented as a percentage of the purchase price.

- Buyback for 24 month period
- Buyback for 36 month period
- Buyback for 48 month period

Bidder is to specify any and all terms and conditions of a buyback agreement. A buyback option shall not be a consideration in determining the lowest responsive and responsible bid. Failure to provide a buyback option will not eliminate the bidder from participating in this ITB.

3.4.3 Leasing

The City is eager to explore leasing options. If a lease option is available, please include the following with the lease package:

- Lease term
- Lease price per truck
- End of lease purchase options
- Detailed conditions of the leasing proposal including, but not limited to any mileage/hour limitations, and the specific conditions of returning the vehicle at the end of the term
- A list of current or past customers, with current contact information, that have utilized a similar lease program (include in Reference)

Failure to provide a leasing option will not eliminate the bidder from participating in this ITB. Lease pricing will only be a consideration of award if the City chooses to lease any or all trucks.

3.5 Warranty**3.5.1 Warranty of Title**

The successful Bidder warrants that all goods and materials furnished under the Contract will be new unless otherwise specified and that successful Bidder possesses good, clear, and marketable title to said goods and there are no pending liens, claims or encumbrances whatsoever against said goods. All work not conforming to these requirements, including substitutions not properly approved and authorized may be considered defective.

3.5.2 Warranty of Specifications

The successful Bidder warrants that all goods, materials and workmanship furnished, whether furnished by the successful Bidder or its sub-contractors and suppliers, will comply with the specifications, drawings, and other descriptions supplied or adopted.

3.5.3 Warranty of Merchantability

The Successful Bidder warrants that the goods to be supplied pursuant to the contract are merchantable, of good quality and free from defects, whether patent or latent in material or workmanship.

3.5.4 Warranty of Material and Workmanship

The successful Bidder warrants all material and workmanship for a minimum of one (1) year from date of completion and acceptance by the City. If within the warranty period, or within such larger period of time as may be prescribed by law or warranted by the Bidder and product manufacturers, any of the work is found to be defective or not in accordance with the contract documents, the successful Bidder shall after receipt of a written notice from the City to do so, promptly correct the work unless the City has previously given the successful Bidder a written acceptance of such condition.

3.5.5 Warranty of Intellectual Property

The Successful Bidder warrants that there has been no violation of copyright, patent, or other intellectual property rights either in the United States of America or in foreign countries in connection with the work of the contract.

3.5.6 All warranties made by the Successful Bidder together with service warranties and guarantees shall become the City's and the successors and assigns of the City.

3.6 Delivery

All items shall be delivery FOB destination to a specified City address. All delivery costs and charges must be included in the bid price. The City reserves the right to cancel orders or any part thereof, without obligation if delivery is not made at the time specified in the bid.

3.7 Title

The successful Bidder shall provide the City with a clear and marketable title at the time of delivery.

3.8 Training

Separate operator and technician training shall be provided by the successful bidder. Training shall be conducted at the City's fleet maintenance facility and training sessions shall be divided into small groups to ensure each operator and each technician receives adequate training on the operational and maintenance aspects of both the body and the chassis.

3.9 Samples and Demonstrations

When requested, samples are to be furnished free of charge to the City. If a sample is requested it must be delivered within seven (7) days of the request unless otherwise stated in the bid. Each sample must be marked with the Bidder's name and manufacturer's brand name. The City will not be responsible for returning samples. The City may request a full demonstration of any product or service before the award of a contract. All demonstrations shall be done at the expense of the Bidder.

3.10 Quantities

No guarantee or warranty is given or implied by the City as to the amount that may or not be purchased from any resulting contract. The City reserves the right to increase or decrease quantities or add or delete any item from the contract if it is determined to be in the best interest of the City at its sole discretion.

3.11 Required Documents

The following documents shall be submitted in the order listed below as a condition of this ITB at the time of submittal with the Bidder's response:

- 4) Required Licenses and Certifications (if applicable)

3.12. Insurance Requirements

3.12.1 Coverage

Successful Bidder shall, at a minimum, provide, pay for, and maintain in force at all times during the term of this Contract the following insurance.

3.12.1.1 Commercial Liability Insurance

A Commercial Liability Insurance Policy shall be provided which shall contain minimum limits of One Million Dollars (\$1,000,000.00) per occurrence combined single limit for bodily injury liability and property damage liability and shall contain minimum limits of Two Million Dollars (\$2,000,000.00) per aggregate. Coverage must be afforded on a form no more restrictive than the latest edition of the Commercial Liability Policy, without restrictive endorsements, as filed by the Insurance Services Office and must include:

- Premises and/or operations
- Independent contractors
- Products and/or completed operations for contracts
- Broad form contractual coverage applicable to this specific Contract, including any hold harmless and/or Indemnification Contract
- Personal injury coverage with employee and contractual exclusions removed, with minimum limits of coverage equal to those required for bodily Injury liability and property damage liability.

3.12.1.2 Business Automobile Liability

Business Automobile Liability shall be provided with minimum limits of One Million Dollars (\$1,000,000.00) per occurrence, combined single limit for Bodily Injury Liability and Property Damage Liability. Coverage must be afforded on a form no more restrictive than the latest edition of the Business Automobile Liability policy, without restrictive endorsements, as filed by the Insurance Services Office, and must include:

- Owned Vehicles, if applicable.
- Hired and Non-Owned Vehicles, if applicable.
- Employers' Non-Ownership, if applicable.

3.12.1.3 Workers Compensation Insurance

Workers' Compensation insurance to apply for all employees in compliance with Chapter 440, Florida Statutes, as may be amended from time to time, the "Workers' Compensation Law" of the State of Florida, and all applicable federal laws. In addition, the policy(ies) must include:

Employers' Liability with a limit of One Million Dollars (\$1,000,000.00) each accident.

3.12.2 General

If any operations are to be undertaken on or about navigable waters, coverage must be included for the U.S. Longshoremen & Harbor Workers Act and Jones Act.

3.12.2.1 Such policy or policies shall be without any deductible amount unless otherwise noted in this Contract and shall be issued by approved companies authorized to do business in the State of Florida, and having agents upon whom service of process may be made in Broward County, Florida. Contractor shall pay all deductible amounts, if any. Contractor shall specifically protect City and the Deerfield Beach City Commission by naming City and the Deerfield Beach City Commission as additional insured under the Commercial Liability Policy as well as on any Excess Liability Policy coverage.

3.12.2.2 Contractor shall furnish to City's Contract Administrator Certificate of Insurance or endorsements evidencing the insurance coverage specified herein within fifteen (15) calendar days after notification of award of the Contract. The required Certificates of Insurance shall name the types of policies provided, refer specifically to this Contract, and state that such insurance is as required by this Contract. Contractor's failure to provide to City the Certificates of Insurance or endorsements evidencing the insurance coverage within fifteen (15) calendar days shall provide the basis for the termination of the Contract.

3.12.2.3 Coverage is not to cease and is to remain in force (subject to cancellation notice) until all performance required of Contractor is complete. All policies must be endorsed to provide City with at least thirty (30) days' notice of expiration, cancellation and/or restriction. If any of the insurance coverages will expire prior to the completion of the work, copies of renewal policies shall be furnished at least thirty (30) days prior to the date of their expiration.

3.12.2.4 City reserves the right to review and revise any insurance requirements at the time of renewal or amendment of this Contract, including, but not limited to, deductibles, limits, coverage, and endorsements based on insurance market conditions affecting the availability or affordability of coverage, or changes in the scope of work or specifications that affect the applicability of coverage. If Contractor uses a subcontractor, Contractor shall ensure that subcontractor names City as an additional insured.

SECTION 4 - TECHNICAL SPECIFICATIONS**4.1. General**

- 4.1.1 If exception is taken to these specifications, bidder must explain each exception in detail. Exceptions to these specifications do not mean automatic disqualification provided the excepted item(s) meets or exceeds the performance the specification intends. All exceptions shall be stated in the Variance to the ITB.
- 4.1.2 The Bidder shall supply features that are regularly furnished as standard for this type of vehicle. Any accessories and/or components not specifically mentioned within these specifications that are necessary to complete the unit and make ready for use shall be included.
- 4.1.3 Successful Bidder shall provide a total of two (2) complete sets of chassis, body, parts, and maintenance manuals. This quantity will not vary regardless of the number of trucks actually purchased. (Disk-based manuals are acceptable providing they are completely categorized, organized and properly labeled.)
- 4.1.4 One (1) printed operator's manual shall be provided for each truck purchased.
- 4.1.5 Successful Bidder shall provide complete chassis and body specifications with their bid.

4.2 Chassis

- 4.2.1 Chassis shall be an Autocar model ACX64 and be fully capable of accommodating a fully functioning automated side loader garbage truck body.
- 4.2.2 Chassis shall be designed for refuse applications and include all components normally supplied, even if such components are not specifically mentioned within this specification.
- 4.2.3 Chassis shall be the most current model year available at time of bid. However, special considerations may be given for pre-urea chassis (if available).
- 4.2.4 Chassis gross vehicle weight rating (GVWR) shall be not less than 66,000 lbs.
- 4.2.5 Wheelbase shall be approximately 221 inches.
- 4.2.6 The chassis shall include a Cummins ISL 8.9L diesel engine with no less than 345 horsepower.
- 4.2.6.1 Engine shall be "Clean Idle" certified.
- 4.2.6.2 Engine idle shutdown shall be enabled for a 5 minute shutdown.
- 4.2.7 The chassis shall include an Allison 4500 RDS transmission designed and geared for the refuse service and include synthetic transmission fluid.
- 4.2.8 Rear tires shall be 315/80R22.5 and be the same as or equal to Goodyear G289.
- 4.2.8.1 Nine inch (9") wheels (rims) shall be provided on all axle positions.





- 4.1.3 Successful Bidder shall provide a total of two (2) complete sets of chassis, body, parts, and maintenance manuals. This quantity will not vary regardless of the number of trucks actually purchased. (Disk-based manuals are acceptable providing they are completely categorized, organized and properly labeled.)
- 4.1.4 One (1) printed operator's manual shall be provided for each truck purchased.
- 4.1.5 Successful Bidder shall provide complete chassis and body specifications with their bid.

4.2 Chassis

- 4.2.1 Chassis shall be an Autocar model ACX64 and be fully capable of accommodating a fully functioning automated side loader garbage truck body.
- 4.2.2 Chassis shall be designed for refuse applications and include all components normally supplied, even if such components are not specifically mentioned within this specification.
- 4.2.3 Chassis shall be the most current model year available at time of bid. However, special considerations may be given for pre-urea chassis (if available).
- 4.2.4 Chassis gross vehicle weight rating (GVWR) shall be not less than 66,000 lbs.
- 4.2.5 Wheelbase shall be approximately 221 inches.
- 4.2.6 The chassis shall include a Cummins ISL 8.9L diesel engine with no less than 345 horsepower.
- 4.2.6.1 Engine shall be "Clean Idle" certified.
- 4.2.6.2 Engine idle shutdown shall be enabled for a 5 minute shutdown.
- 4.2.7 The chassis shall include an Allison 4500 RDS transmission designed and geared for the refuse service and include synthetic transmission fluid.
- 4.2.8 Front and Rear tires shall be 315/80R22.5 and be the same as or equal to Goodyear G289 load range L.
- 4.2.8.1 Nine inch (9") wheels (rims) shall be provided on all axle positions.
- 4.2.9 Chassis shall include a front-mounted PTO for use with the refuse body.
- 4.2.9.1 PTO shall be mounted behind the bumper.



- 4.2.10 Chassis shall include dual steer capabilities with left and right hand seated positions.
- 4.2.10.1 Low-back air ride seats shall be provided in both seating positions.
- 4.2.11 Factory air conditioning shall be provided.
- 4.2.12 Chassis frame rails shall include an inner liner to provide frame reinforcement.
- 4.2.13 Chassis and engine mounted fuel filters shall be easily accessible by maintenance personnel.
- 4.2.14 Fuel tanks capacity shall be approximately 75 US gallons.
- 4.2.15 Coolant hoses shall be silicone type with steel tubing.
- 4.2.16 Air tanks shall be mounted to the frame rails and include an air dryer.
- 4.2.16.1 Wet tank(s) shall incorporate an automatic moisture ejection system.
- 4.2.17 A battery shutoff switch shall be installed and be easily accessible.
- 4.2.17.1 Shutoff switch shall be wired to roof mounted auxiliary lights to indicate a "battery on" condition.
- 4.2.18 Power mirrors shall be provided on both sides of the cab and include retractable mirror arms.
- 4.2.19 Auxiliary mirrors shall be 8" round convex mirror with offset ball-stud.
- 4.2.20 Twin air horns shall be mounted under the cab. Air horn pull cords shall be accessible from either position.
- 4.2.21 Cab tilt mechanism shall be hydraulic tilt with air assist.
- 4.2.22 Air conditioning with heating/defrosting shall be provided.
- 4.2.23 A fire extinguisher, not less than 5lbs. shall be provided and mounted in a suitable location for easy access under the driverside cab seat.
- 4.2.24 A road safety kit shall be provided.
- 4.2.25 A total of three sets of keys shall be provided.
- 4.2.26 A backup alarm shall be provided. Audible alarm shall increase in volume as the backing vehicle approaches objects.
- 4.3 **Automated Side Loader Collection Body**
- 4.3.1 The refuse body shall be the same as or equal to Heil MS DuraPack 7000 and capable of servicing approximately 1,200 homes per day.
- 4.3.2 The refuse body shall be a minimum ~~twenty-five (25)~~ twenty-seven (27) cubic yards capacity, exclusive of the hopper.



- 4.2.9 Chassis shall include a front-mounted PTO for use with the refuse body.
 - 4.2.9.1 PTO shall be mounted behind the bumper.
- 4.2.10 Chassis shall include dual steer capabilities with left and right hand seated positions.
 - 4.2.10.1 Low-back air ride seats shall be provided in both seating positions.
- 4.2.11 Factory air conditioning shall be provided.
- 4.2.12 Chassis frame rails shall include an inner liner to provide frame reinforcement.
- 4.2.13 Chassis and engine mounted fuel filters shall be easily accessible by maintenance personnel.
- 4.2.14 Fuel tanks capacity shall be approximately 75 US gallons.
- 4.2.15 Coolant hoses shall be silicone type with steel tubing.
- 4.2.16 Air tanks shall be mounted to the frame rails and include an air dryer.
 - 4.2.16.1 Wet tank(s) shall incorporate an automatic moisture ejection system.
- 4.2.17 A battery shutoff switch shall be installed and be easily accessible.
 - 4.2.17.1 Shutoff switch shall be wired to roof mounted auxiliary lights to indicate a "battery on" condition.
- 4.2.18 Power mirrors shall be provided on both sides of the cab and include retractable mirror arms.
- 4.2.19 Auxiliary mirrors shall be 8" round convex mirror with offset ball-stud.
- 4.2.20 Twin air horns shall be mounted under the cab. Air horn pull cords shall be accessible from either position.
- 4.2.21 Cab tilt mechanism shall be hydraulic tilt with air assist.
- 4.2.22 Air conditioning with heating/defrosting shall be provided.
- 4.2.23 A fire extinguisher shall be provided and mounted in a suitable location for easy access.
- 4.2.24 A road safety kit shall be provided.
- 4.2.25 A total of three sets of keys shall be provided.
- 4.2.26 A backup alarm shall be provided. Audible alarm shall increase in volume as the backing vehicle approaches objects.

4.3 Automated Side Loader Collection Body

- 4.3.1 The refuse body shall be the same as or equal to Heil MS DuraPack 7000 and capable of servicing approximately 1,200 homes per day.
- 4.3.2 The refuse body shall be a minimum twenty-five (25) cubic yards capacity, exclusive of the hopper.

- 4.3.3 The hopper shall have a minimum capacity of four (4) cubic yards.
- 4.3.4 The packer body shall be capable of packing 900 pounds per cubic yard based on average household refuse.
- 4.3.5 Packer body must meet all applicable ANSI safety standards.
- 4.3.6 The body shall be capable of compacting and transporting refuse to a landfill or transfer station.
- 4.3.7 Body shall include a full-eject hydraulic method of dispensing the refuse load. Tilt body ejection is unacceptable.
- 4.3.8 Maximum outside body width shall be 96".
- 4.3.9 The maximum outside body height above chassis shall be 98".
- 4.3.10 All sidewall and roof members shall be continuous welded.
- 4.3.11 Refuse body shall include one (1) hopper camera and one (1) back up camera with a single monitor mounted within easy view of the operator.

4.4 Hopper Construction

- 4.4.1 Hopper shall be designed to properly handle 30 - 100 gallon automated side loader carts.
- 4.4.2 Hopper floor shall be constructed of a minimum .25" 150,000 PSI minimum yield steel plate.
- 4.4.3 Hopper sides shall be constructed of a minimum .1875" 150,000 PSI minimum yield steel sheet.
- 4.4.4 A hopper sump shall be provided in forward floor area of the hopper. Sump shall have a 40 gallon minimum capacity and have dual clean-out doors. Clean out doors shall not dump waste material onto chassis components.
- 4.4.5 A tool shall be provided and mounted to provide easy cleanout of the hopper sump.
- 4.4.6 An access door opening shall be provided on hopper left hand side wall. Folding steps and grab handles shall be provided to ease entry.
- 4.4.7 The front of the hopper, forward of the packer mechanism, shall be easily accessible to maintenance personnel.

4.5 Packing Mechanism

- 4.5.1 A hydraulically actuated packer shall clear the hopper of material with an approximate cycle time of fourteen (14) seconds.
- 4.5.2 A proximity switch will automatically reverse the packing cycle and return the packing panel to the front head.
- 4.5.3 An automatic back-up reversing means shall be provided should the packing panel be unable to reach the rearmost packing position of 60".
- 4.5.4 The packing panel face sheet shall be constructed of a minimum .25", 80,000 PSI minimum yield, abrasion resistant steel plate.

- 4.5.5 A spill shield, fabricated from 11 ga., 50,000 PSI minimum yield steel shall be affixed to the top of the packing panel.
- 4.5.6 The packer panel and spill shield shall be reinforced with a combination of structural members for maximum rigidity.
- 4.5.7 Hopper zone guide rails (2) in the side of the body shall be comprised of a .25", 50,000 PSI minimum yield formed angle welded to 3.5" x 3.5" x .3125" ASTM A500 tubing on each side of body. The tubing shall run the full interior length of the hopper and extend 28" into the body.
- 4.5.8 The packer panel shall be designed to provide easy removal to allow easy access to the packing cylinders.
- 4.5.9 The packing cylinders shall be multi-stage hydraulic cylinders with chrome plated tubes (or approved equivalent).
- 4.5.10 Packing force shall be a approximately 83,000 pounds. Cylinder force shall be a approximately 118,000 pounds.
- 4.5.11 The packer shall be designed to allow dumping of a container regardless of the position of the packing panel during the compaction cycle.
- 4.5.12 The packing mechanism shall be capable of extending to the rearmost end of the body, past full pack position, to provide off-loading function when the tailgate is raised.

4.6 Tailgate

- 4.6.1 The tailgate must be one piece top hinged and shall hydraulically open approximately 30° above horizontal.
- 4.6.2 The tailgate will be secured to the body by two (2) sets of hinges with 2" hinge pins at the roof line.
- 4.6.3 A heavy-duty rear door positive seal of rubberized gasket material shall be installed the full length of the bottom and up the sides of tailgate to prevent leakage.
- 4.6.4 The tailgate shall be raised and lowered hydraulically actuated by two (2) double acting cylinders with chrome plated rod. Cylinder design shall include an orifice fitting in the base port, which shall prevent rapid descent of the tailgate in the event of a hydraulic failure.
- 4.6.5 The tailgate shall be locked by two (2) cylinders with hardened chrome plated rods.

4.7 Lifting Mechanism

- 4.7.1 A hydraulic lifting arm shall be mounted to the chassis and be capable of servicing approximately 1,200 homes per day.
- 4.7.2 The hydraulic lifting arm shall be capable of gripping and lifting refuse containers ranging from 30 – 100 gallons.
- 4.7.3 The hydraulic lifting arm shall be capable of extending, grabbing, raising, dumping and returning a container from any position without the need to retract the lift arm.

- 4.7.4 The hydraulic lifting arm shall perform the following lift cycle functions in approximately eight (8) seconds at idle: Grab the container, lift the container to the full dump position, dump the container, lower the container to the full down position, and release the grabbers from the container.
- 4.7.5 An automated lubrication system shall be provided and supply on-demand grease to all pivot points on the automated arm and gripper assembly.
- 4.7.6 The hydraulic lifting arm capacity shall be approximately 2,000 pounds at any extension.
- 4.7.7 The hydraulic lifting arm shall have an approximate reach of 72".
- 4.7.8 The hydraulic lifting arm shall be powered by cylinders with cushions at each end of the stroke.
- 4.7.9 The three lift mechanism cylinders shall have hardened and chrome plated rods.
- 4.7.10 The hydraulic lifting arm shall have adjustable and changeable grabbers.
- 4.7.11 The hydraulic lifting arm shall be within the 96" road limit in the down and stowed position with approximately 13" of ground clearance.


4.8 Hydraulics

- 4.8.1 The maximum operating pressures shall be 2500 PSI.
- 4.8.2 The hydraulic system shall operate at an acceptable temperature without the need for external hydraulic oil cooling devices.
- 4.8.3 The hydraulic pump shall be a front-mounted, tandem vane pump with electronic over-speed control. The combined flow shall be 26 GPM @ 700 RPM. The packer panel pump shall flow up to a maximum 37 GPM @ 1800 RPM. Pump shall comply with specification 219-2291 or equal.
- 4.8.4 The lift hydraulics shall operate at a working pressure of 2000 PSI.
- 4.8.5 All hydraulic tubes will be securely clamped to prevent vibration, abrasion, and excessive noise.
- 4.8.6 All hydraulic hoses shall conform to SAE standards for designed pressure. All high pressure hoses shall be sleeved with fabric guard for added protection.
- 4.8.7 The hydraulic reservoir shall have an approximate 50 gallon gross capacity and a 45 gallon net capacity.
- 4.8.8 The tank shall be complete with a screened fill pipe and cap, filter breather, clean out cover, oil level sight and temperature gauge, and suction line shut-off valve.
- 4.8.9 The hydraulic system shall be protected by a three (3) micron, in-tank, return line filter along with a 100 mesh (140 micron) reusable oil strainer in the suction line.

- 4.7.4 The hydraulic lifting arm shall perform the following lift cycle functions in approximately eight (8) seconds at idle: Grab the container, lift the container to the full dump position, dump the container, lower the container to the full down position, and release the grabbers from the container.
- 4.7.5 An automated lubrication system shall be provided and supply on-demand grease to all pivot points on the automated arm and gripper assembly.
- 4.7.6 The hydraulic lifting arm capacity shall be approximately 2,000 at least 1,000 pounds at any extension.
- 4.7.7 The hydraulic lifting arm shall have an approximate reach of 72".
- 4.7.8 The hydraulic lifting arm shall be powered by cylinders with cushions at each end of the stroke.
- 4.7.9 The three lift mechanism cylinders shall have hardened and chrome plated rods.
- 4.7.10 The hydraulic lifting arm shall have adjustable and changeable grabbers.
- 4.7.11 The hydraulic lifting arm shall be within the 96" road limit in the down and stowed position with approximately 13" of ground clearance.

4.8 Hydraulics

- 4.8.1 The maximum operating pressures shall be 2500 PSI.
- 4.8.2 The hydraulic system shall operate at an acceptable temperature without the need for external hydraulic oil cooling devices.

- 4.8.6 All hydraulic hoses shall conform to SAE standards for designed pressure. All high pressure hoses shall be sleeved with fabric guard for added protection.
- 4.8.7 The hydraulic reservoir shall have an approximate 50 gallon gross capacity and a 45 gallon net capacity.
- 4.8.8 The tank shall be complete with a screened fill pipe and cap, filter breather, clean out cover, oil level sight and temperature gauge, and suction line shut-off valve.
- 4.8.9 The hydraulic system shall be protected by a three (3) micron, in-tank, return line filter along with a 100 mesh (140 micron) reusable oil strainer in the suction line.




- 4.8.10 The return line filter shall also include an in-cab filter by-pass monitor, which shall alert the operator or service personnel when the filter is in need of replacement.
- 4.8.11 A hydraulic pump shut down system shall also be included, which shall prohibit prolonged operation of the hydraulics when the filter is in the by-pass mode.

4.9 Controls

- 4.9.1 The hydraulic lifting arm controls shall be air over hydraulic joystick style located in the cab in a convenient position for the operator.
- 4.9.2 ~~The hydraulic lifting arm controls shall be of a three lever design.~~ Each control lever shall be properly labeled for function.






Questions and Answers

- Q1** I am concerned with the wording of section 2.22.2 "Termination for Convenience." Could you please clarify this section?
- A1** This is a General Term and Condition that is standard in the City's Invitations to Bid. This clause should not be interpreted as a means for the City to cancel an order authorized through the issuance of a purchase order when the Contractor is performing as required by the Contract. This clause may be invoked should incurable performance and/or delivery issues exist.
- Q2** Section 4.3.2 requests a minimum of 25 yards body capacity. Sunbelt has delivered 28 yard units in the past, but has available from Heil a 26 yard unit. I do not believe that the City wants a 26 yard unit but we would be forced to bid that for competitive pricing reasons. Please address this issue.
- A2** Refer to Page 21(a)
- Q3** Section 4.2.23 requests in chassis specs a fire extinguisher. The chassis will come with a small one. (Less than 5 lb.) But in the past we have supplied and mounted 20 lb. fire extinguisher on the driver side of the body. There appears to be no request in body specs for one. Please address this issue.
- A3** Refer to Page 21(a)
- Q4** Section 4.11.3 specifies LED lights. All recent deliveries to the City of Deerfield Beach have had strobing "SMART" rear lights. Does the City want this added to the Bid?
- A4** No
- Q5** The City of Deerfield Beach has always received their trucks with Hopper Work Lights. That is not in the specifications. Do you want this added to the Bid?
- A5** Refer to Page 26(a)

A bid/proposal submitted with an intentional substantive variation to a basic provision, specification, term or condition of the solicitation. 




