4. CRIME STATS SUMMARY

5. CHIEFS LETTER TO THE ADVISORY COUNCIL

Sergeant Thouez distributed a letter to everyone from Chief Flourney to invite them to attend a meeting to discuss a new security company with the board of directors/City Commission.

6. 2012/2013 BUDGET

Sergeant Thouez provided a copy of the budget and explained the only change from last year to this year's proposed budget would include a camera upgrade. Mr. Lovenvirth called for a board member vote on approving the budget. Seven (7) of the eleven (11) members were in attendance resulting in a quorum for the vote. **Unanimous Approval 710.**

7. SPECIAL PROJECTS

A. Lane Closure Grant – Engineering

Richard Labinsky provided an overview about a DOT Grant opportunity to make roadway changes along Parkview Drive to the bridge. The City has approved applying for the grant and tonight Mr. Labinsky was asking for signatures to show resident support for the grant. There were several negative comments about traffic congestion from the lane changes and the addition of roundabouts.

B. Upgrading Surveillance System

The increase cost of a camera upgrade is estimated to cost \$34,000.00. Mr. Lovenvirth called for a member vote to approve the camera upgrade. **Unanimous Approval 710.**

C. Call Boxes

Sergeant Thouez distributed information regarding the call boxes and explained the three options (A, B, C) available for an emergency call box at each guardhouse location. Option A & B does not include installation costs and Option C was the most expensive option. Armin Lovenvirth thought it best for the item to be tabled.

Vice Mayor Sanders addressed the meeting and provided his contact information. Commissioner Lewy also addressed the meeting and talked about the upcoming roadway projects.

D. Median Up Lighting

Sergeant Thouez addressed the median lighting is not yet completed. The Up Lighting is expected to be done by February 24th.

DISCUSSION

Sergeant Thouez received numerous concerns about the possibility of a roundabout along Three Islands Boulevard and Atlantic Shores Boulevard.
