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RESOLUTION NO. 2021 - 040

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HALLANDALE BEACH, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING REJECTION OF ALL BIDS RECEIVED IN CONNECTION WITH INVITATION TO BID NO. FY 2019-2020-008 INFILTRATION AND INFLOW REMOVAL PHASE 2A LATERAL REPAIRS; AUTHORIZING RE-ADVERTISEMENT; AUTHORIZING CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE RELATED DOCUMENTS; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, infiltration and inflow (I&I) is ground water that enters the City's sewer system through cracks and/or breaches in the pipelines, which increases the volume of sewage conveyed in the system and ultimately the amount paid to the City of Hollywood by the City for wastewater treatment; and

WHEREAS, the City has performed studies and rehabilitation work to 1) reduce I&I throughout its wastewater collection system, 2) help to increase the system's capacity for base and peak flows and 3) strengthen preventative maintenance and operations activities by identifying and repairing any breaches/cracks in the pipelines, and broke the work down to two phases known as Phase 2 – Mainline Repairs and Phase 2A – Lateral Repairs; and

WHEREAS, in connection with the first phase, on February 19, 2019, the City released Invitation to Bid (ITB) FY 2018-2019-003 and is now near completion of Phase 2 – Mainline Repairs to reduce infiltration and inflow (I&I) throughout its wastewater collection system; and

WHEREAS, in connection with the second phase, on August 11, 2020, the City released Invitation to Bid (ITB) FY 2019-2020-008 Infiltration and Inflow Removal Phase 2A - Lateral Repairs; and

WHEREAS, Invitation to Bid (ITB) FY 2019-2020-008 Infiltration and Inflow Removal Phase 2A - Lateral Repairs was sent via email to over six hundred (600) vendors; and

WHEREAS, the three proposals received by the City were evaluated by the City's consulting firm, Public Utility Management Planning Services, Inc., which firm found all

38 bids to be not responsible or non-responsive due to absence of direct experience, bond
39 requirements and contract bid sheet; and

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41 **WHEREAS**, pursuant to City of Hallandale Beach Code of Ordinances, Chapter
42 23, Section 23-12, Procedures for purchases in excess of \$50,000, (4) Rejection of Bids,
43 the City Commission may authorize City Manager to: a) Reject all bids; or b) reject all
44 bids and re-advertise; and

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46 **WHEREAS**, Staff recommends rejecting all bids and authorizing Staff to re-
47 advertise the second phase of the project and authorizing the City Manager to execute
48 any relating documents.

56 of the City to reject all bids submitted in response to Invitation to Bid (ITB) FY 2019-2020-
57 008 Infiltration and Inflow Removal Phase 2A - Lateral Repairs, and authorize re-
58 advertising the second phase of the project.

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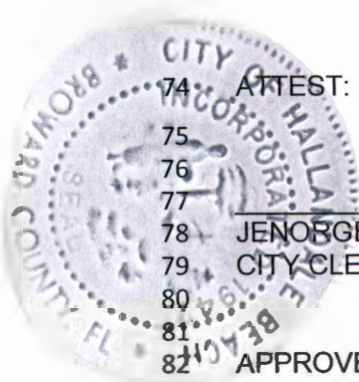
