A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HALLANDALE BEACH, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO REJECT RFP #FY2021-2022-002 CLASSIFICATION AND COMPENSATION STUDY; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO PROCEED IN THE BEST INTEREST OF THE CITY FOR PROCURING THE REQUIRED SERVICES; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, on November 10, 2021, the City of Hallandale Beach released Request for Proposals (RFP) #FY2021-2022-002 Classification and Compensation Study. Notice for the RFP was sent via email to over eight hundred and fifty (850) vendors including vendors from the City's Vendor list; and

WHEREAS, on November 22, 2021, an in-person non-Mandatory Pre-Proposal Conference was held. No firms attended; and

WHEREAS, on January 6, 2022, the City received one (1) response to the RFP solicitation from Manpower Group; and

WHEREAS, on January 26, 2022, the Evaluation Committee held an in-person meeting to evaluate the single proposal received; and

WHEREAS, upon the Evaluation Committee's review of the vendor's submittal of documentation with the minimum requirements of the RFP, it was unanimously determined that the vendor's submittals did not meet the minimum qualification requirements for items #2a, #2c and #2d; and

WHEREAS, City Administration seeks City Commission authorization to reject the lone submitted proposal and authorize the City Manager to proceed in the best interest of the City for procuring the required services.


