QUESTION 1. Will there be a time extension for the submittal date as it takes some time to send and receive references for the required projects.

ANSWER 1. There will be no time extension.

QUESTION 2. Can the City provide water atlas maps for the vicinity of west portion of Holiday Drive, of Holiday Drive, of the sub aqueous WM crossing and of the vicinity of Golden View Condominiums?

QUESTION 3. We noticed there were markings on the road for water and sewer was there a survey made for Holiday Drive and if so, is it possible that the city can provide a copy of the survey at this time?
