A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HALLANDALE BEACH, FLORIDA AWARDED RFP # FY2012-2013-014, TO ACOLITE CLUADE UNITED SIGN COMPANY, INC. (ACU), FOR THE FABRICATION AND INSTALLATION OF THE CITY'S NEW MAIN GATEWAY SIGN, IN THE AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED TWO HUNDRED NINETY THREE THOUSAND THREE HUNDRED EIGHTY TWO (\$293,382) DOLLARS; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO NEGOTIATE AND EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT WITH ACOLITE CLUADE UNITED SIGN COMPANY, INC. (ACU); AND AUTHORIZING AN ADDITIONAL TEN PERCENT (10%) CONTINGENCY FOR UNFORESEEN CIRCUMSTANCES; FURTHER AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ISSUE A SUBSEQUENT REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS (RFP) FOR THE REMAINING SIGNS IN THE PROGRAM, AUTHORIZING THE AWARD OF PROPOSALS TO THE LOWEST RESPONSIBLE BIDDER(S) FOR A TOTAL AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED TWO-HUNDRED AND NINETY-FIVE THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$295,000); AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, one of the City's recent improvements is the implementation of a new City logo; and

WHEREAS, a subsequent step to this process is to upgrade existing signage and to integrate the new logo throughout the City in a systematic manner; and

WHEREAS, the first step is to upgrade the City's main gateway sign located on the southeast corner of I-95 and Hallandale Beach Boulevard; and

WHEREAS, as this is the City's main gateway entry, it is important to enhance this section of the City with a memorable and vibrant entrance sign; and

WHEREAS, the City retained AECOM as a consultant to assist the City in completing a design intent document that would establish basic dimensions of units, profiles, sight lines, and overall appearance of the new sign; and

WHEREAS, City staff reviewed the bid proposals and completed a summary rating sheet, and these ratings were based on firms qualifications and experience, project team experience,

42 examples of past proposals, past performance references, financial resources, cost, crisis
43 management plan, and the City's local vendor preference; and

45 **WHEREAS**, upon completion of staff's review, Acolite Cluade United Sign Company, Inc.
46 (ACU), received the higher score and was determined to be the preferred finalist vendor by the
47 selection committee; and

49 **WHEREAS**, the City Administration is of the belief that it is in the best interest of the City
50 of Hallandale Beach and it's residents that RFP #FY2012-2013-014 for the design, fabrication
51 and installation of the City's new main gateway entrance signage be awarded to Acolite Cluade
52 United Sign Company, Inc., as the responsible, responsive bidder, and that the City Manager be
53 authorized to negotiate and execute an agreement and all related documents to effectuate the
54 project in substantially the same form as attached hereto in Exhibit "A," and to further authorize
55 the City Manager to issue a subsequent Request for Proposals (RFP) for the remaining signs in
56 the program authorizing the award of proposals to the lowest responsible bidder for a total amount
57 not to exceed Two-Hundred and Ninety-Five Thousand Dollars (\$295,000).

59 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COMMISSION**
60 **OF THE CITY OF HALLANDALE BEACH, FLORIDA:**

62 **SECTION 1. Award of Bid.** The Mayor and City Commission hereby award FY2012-
63 2013-014, Sign Fabrication and Installation to Acolite Cluade United Sign Company, Inc.,
64 including the demolition and disposal of the existing signage, as the responsible, responsive
65 bidder in the amount not to exceed Two Hundred Ninety Three Thousand Three Hundred Eighty
66 Two (\$293,382) Dollars, and authorizing a ten percent (10%) contingency for unforeseen
67 circumstances.

68 **SECTION 2. City Manager Authorization.** The Mayor and City Commission hereby
69 authorize the City Manager to negotiate and execute an agreement with Acolite Cluade United
70 Sign Company, Inc., in the amount not to exceed Two Hundred Ninety Three Thousand Three
71 Hundred Eighty Two (\$293,382) Dollars, and authorizing a ten percent (10%) contingency for
72 unforeseen circumstances. The Mayor and City Commission hereby further authorize the City
73 Manager to issue a subsequent Request for Proposals (RFP) for the remaining signs in the

74 Program, authorizing the award of proposals to the lowest responsible bidder for a total amount
75 not to exceed Two Hundred and Ninety-Five Thousand Dollars (\$295,000). .

77 **SECTION 3. Effective Date.** This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its
78 passage and adoption.


